


#### Class 3 Science

Disaster has struck in the Polar regions and the animals are stuck in the ice. Class 3 thought up some good ideas about how to save them. What do you think will be the best idea?




#### Class 3 Science

Class 3 have made playdough sculptures off their favourite Polar animals




Class 3 English

During this week we practised meditation, mindfulness, creating positivity jars, took walks outside and made our own worry dolls.




