CLASS 5 – MAKING SNOWMAN PUPPETS

How to make a snowman puppet

- 1. First, get your snowman cut-outs, a needle and choose a colour of thread.
- 2. Secondly, carefully put the thread through the hole in the needle. Be careful because the hole is small.
- 3. After that, tie a knot in both ends of the thread so it doesn't slip out.
- 4. Next, gently push the needle up and down through the holes to sew them together.
- 5. Then, colour the eyes, gloves, scarf, nose and mouth.
- 6. After that, neatly cut them out. Be careful because the scissors are sharp!
- 7. Finally, use the glue to stick the objects on.
