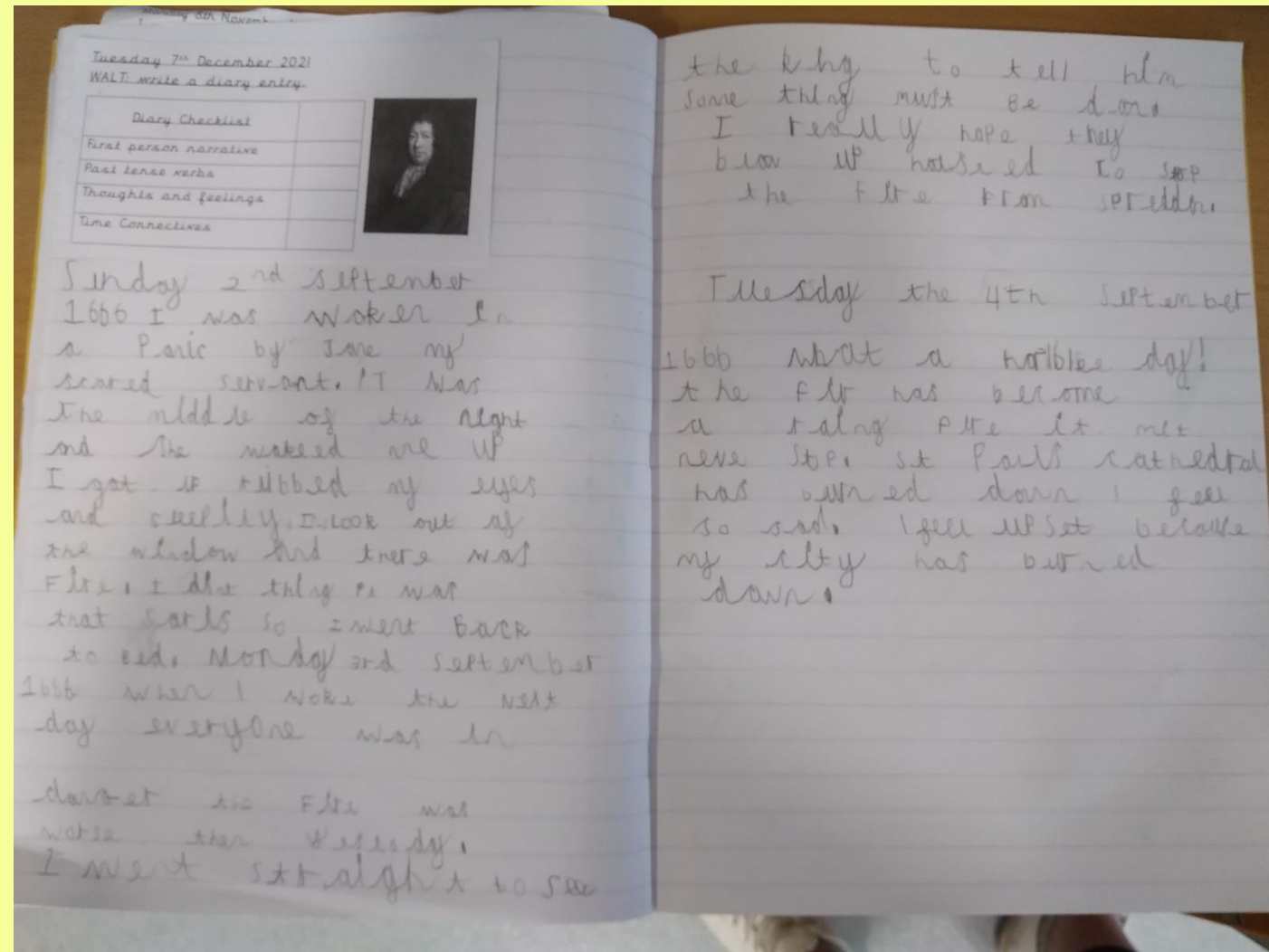

Class 4 - Samuel Pepys diaries

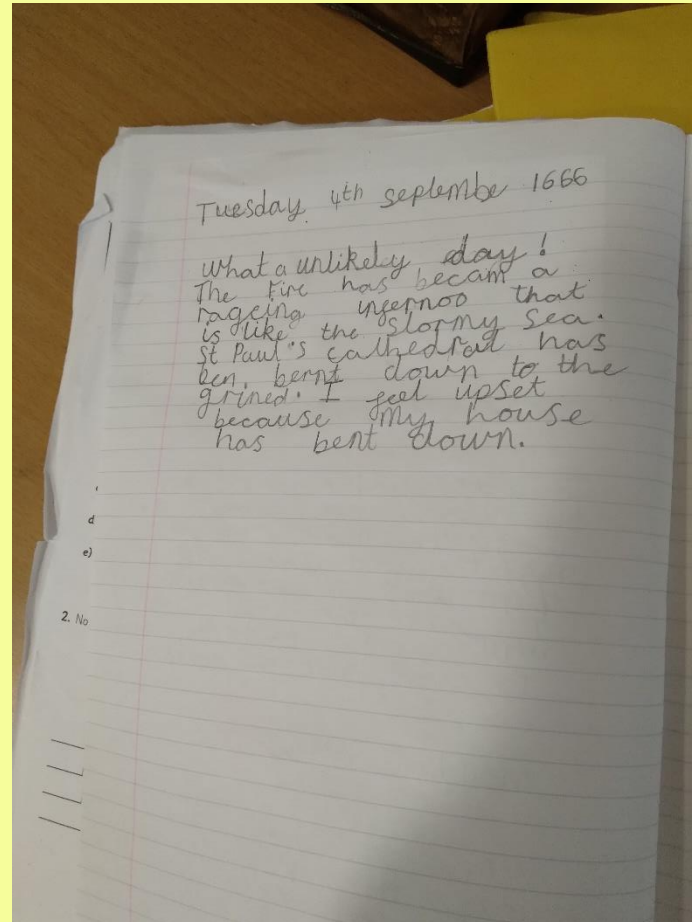
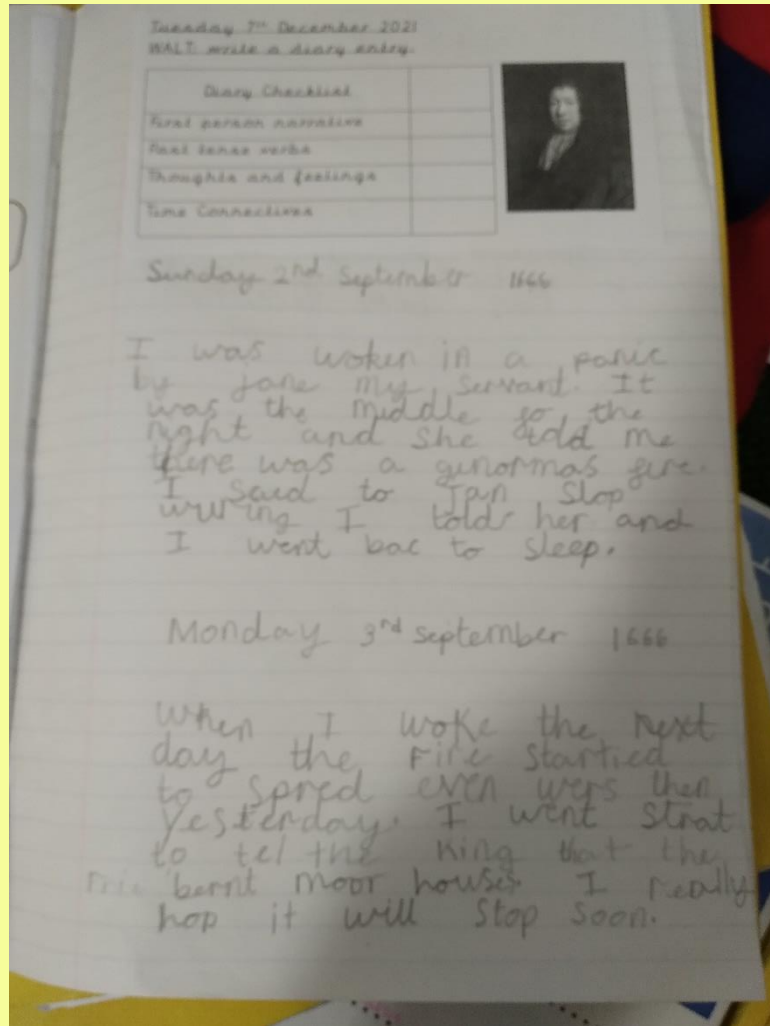

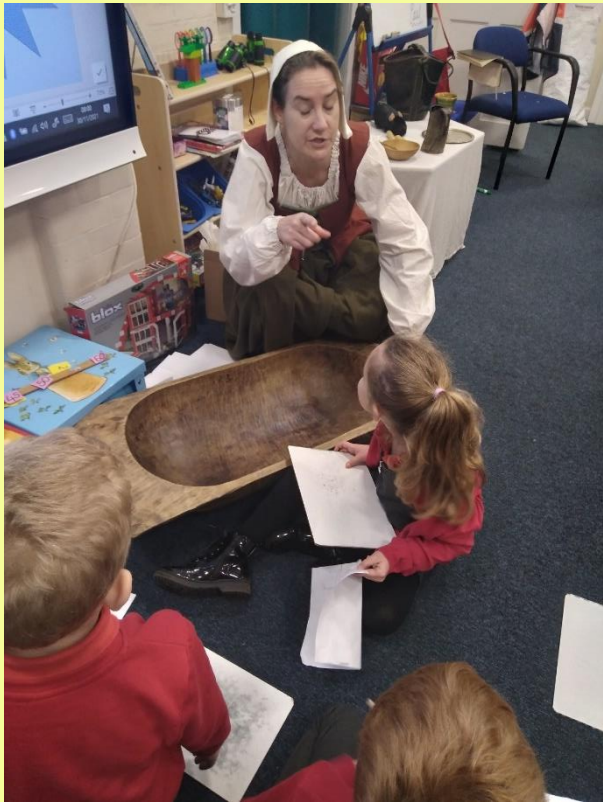
Class 3 Great Fire of London Workshop

Catherine came to visit us with lots of artefacts from 350 years ago. We were able to investigate them and guess what they were made of and what they were used for. What do you think they are?



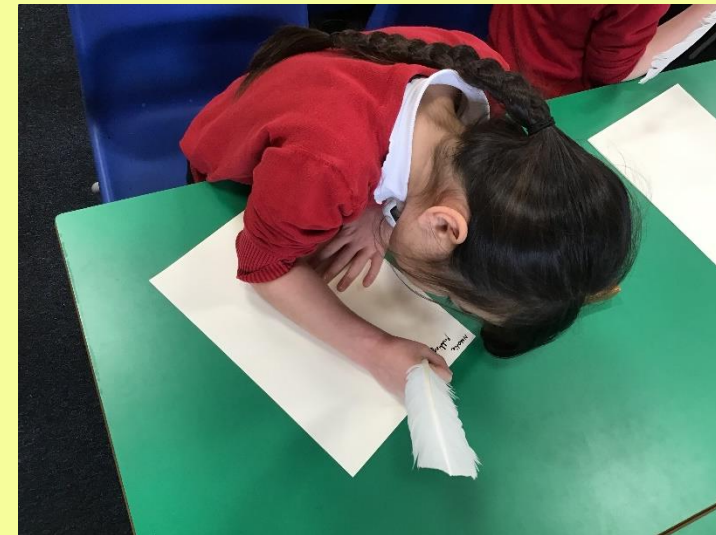
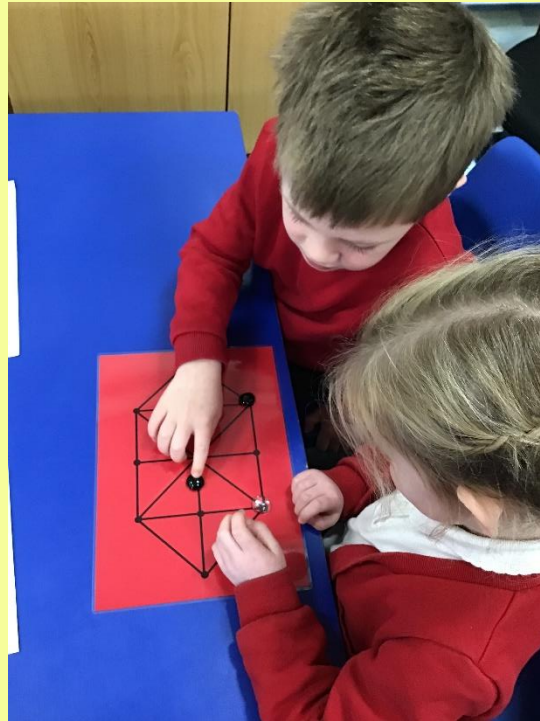
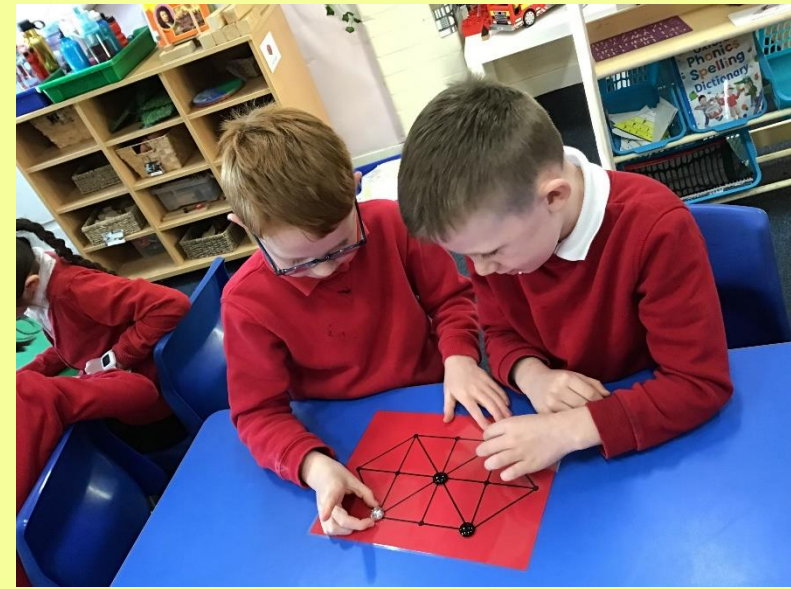
Class 4 Great Fire of London Workshop

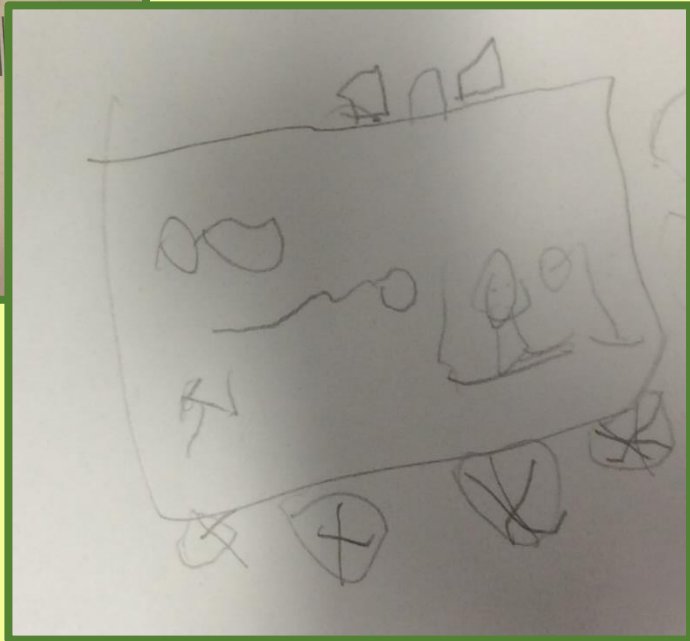
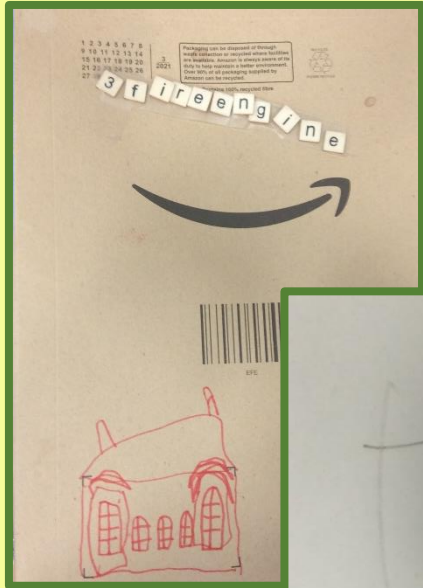


Class 4 artwork

Class 3 home learning challenges



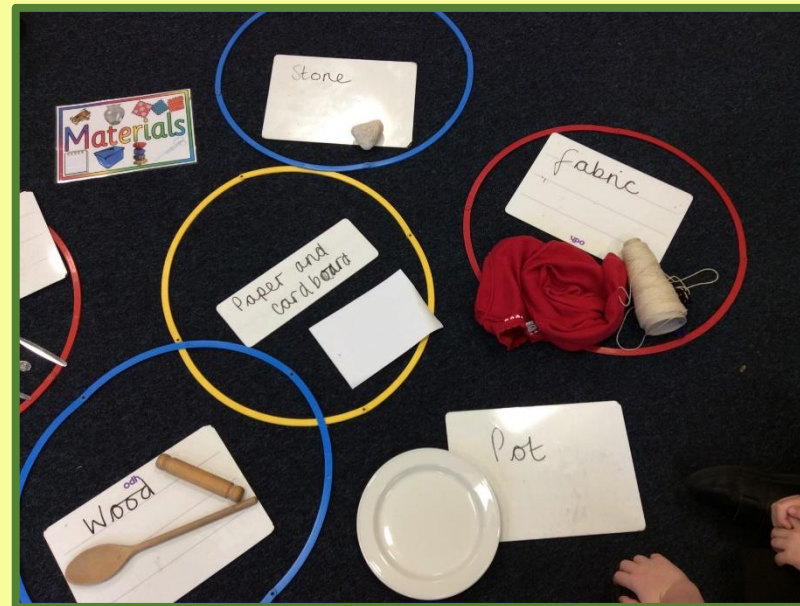
Class 3

This half term we have been learning about materials. Sorting and classifying and heating and cooling.

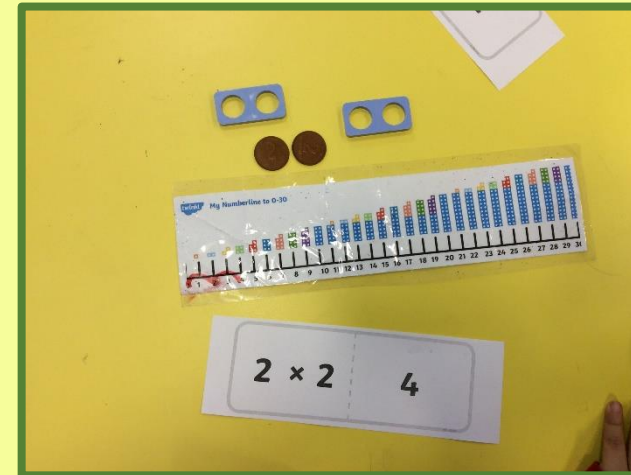
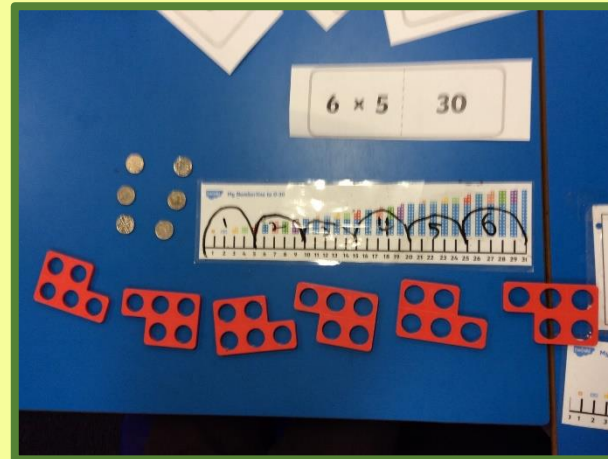
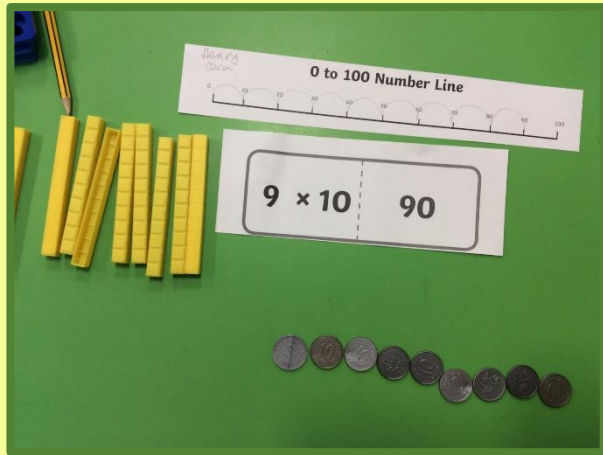
These pictures show how we have sorted materials and melting chocolate to see how heat changes state.

Learning the 2, 5 and 10s times tables

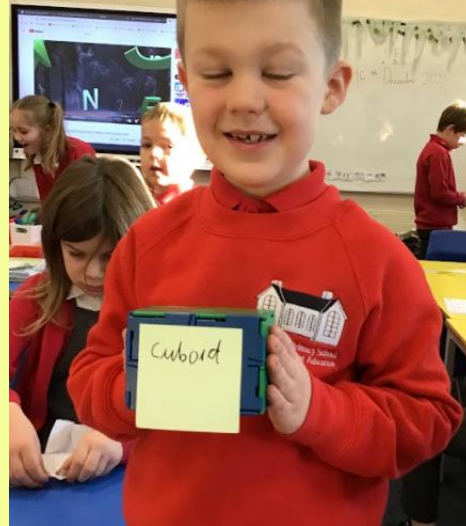
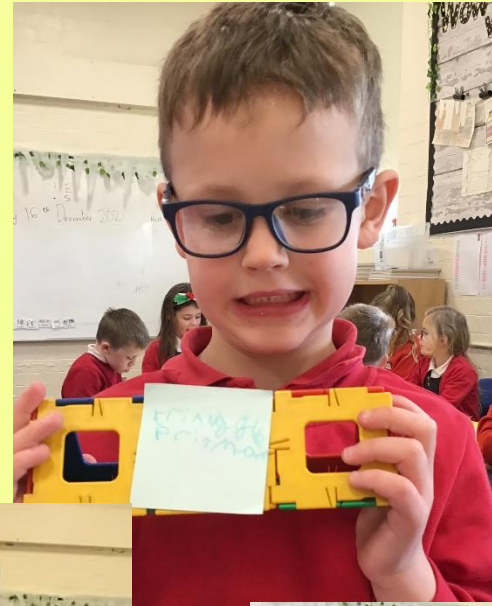


We also learnt the corresponding division facts.
