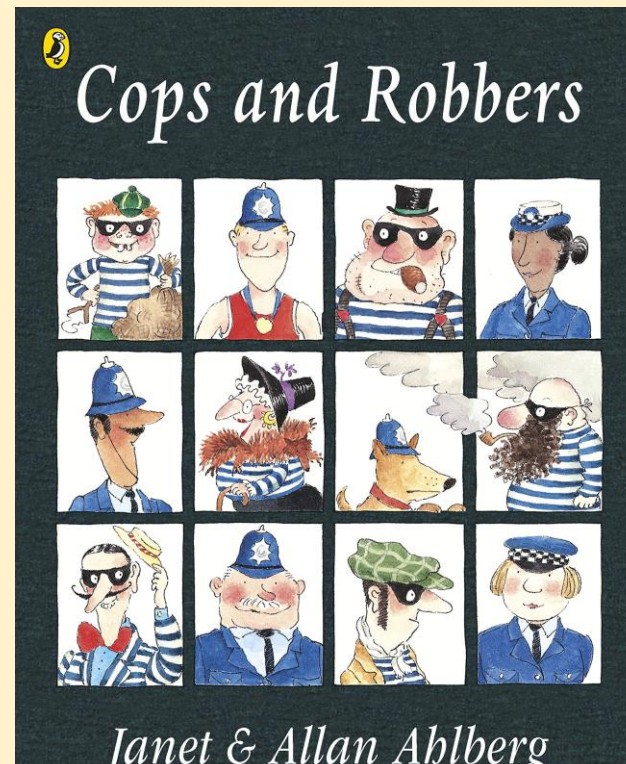

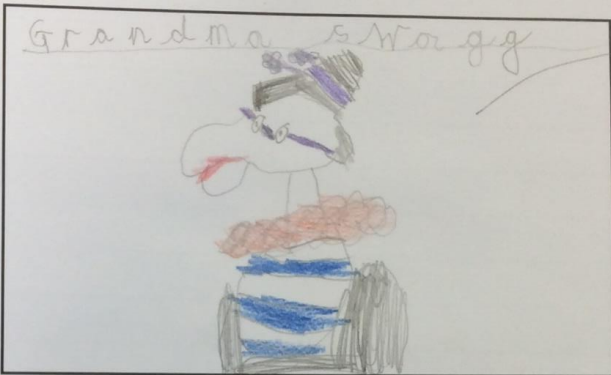
One of our texts has been Cops and Robbers by Janet and Allan Ahlberg. We spent time learning about Grandma Swag and pretending to be the police officers who catch her.

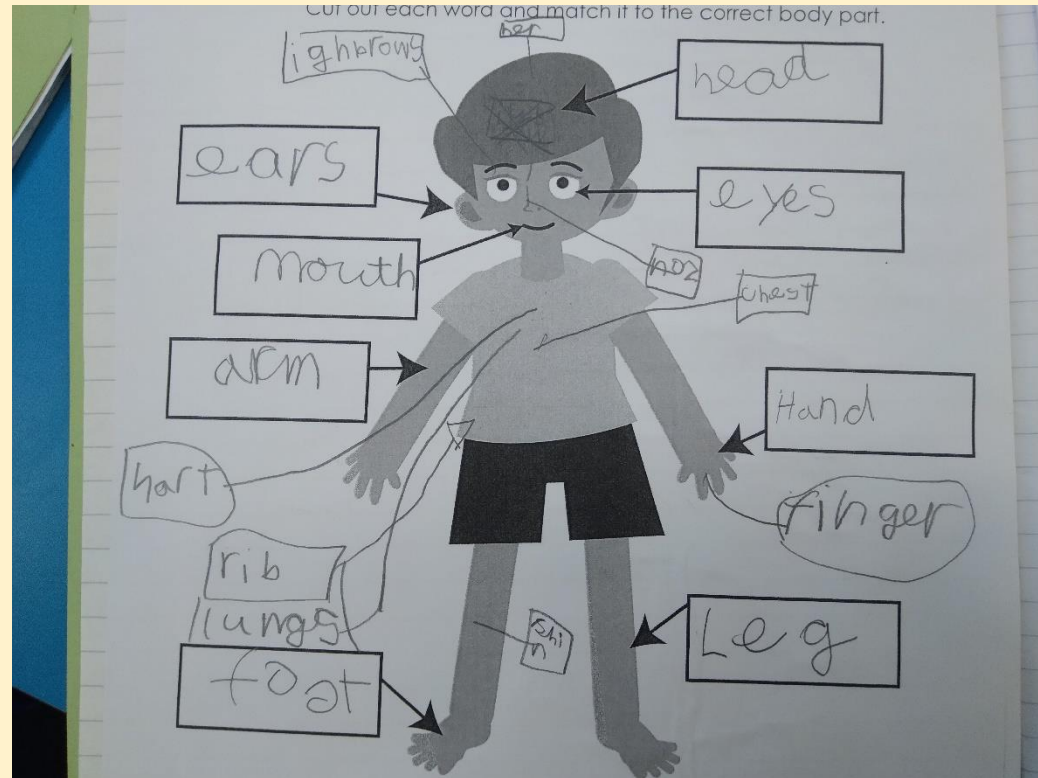
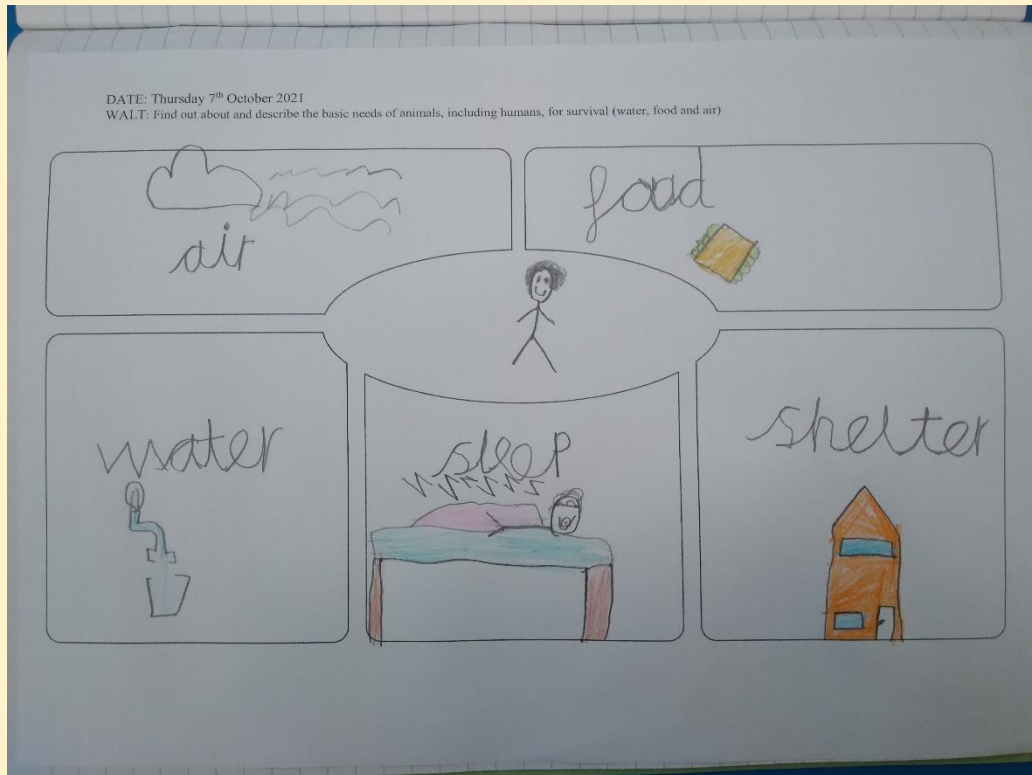

Class 4 – science



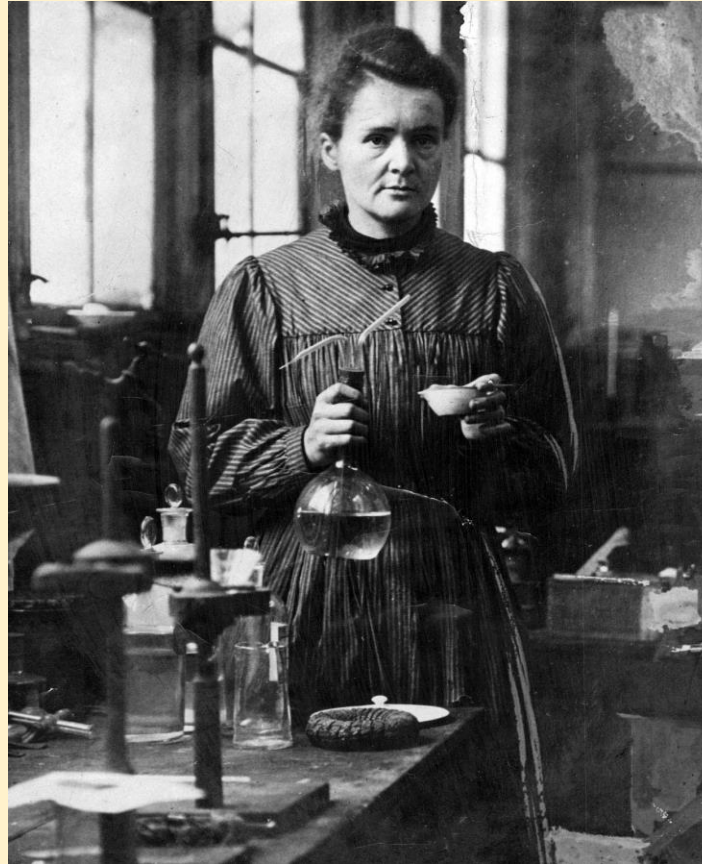
Our science lessons this half term have been all about the human body. We have learnt the scientific names for body parts and explored what humans need in order to survive.

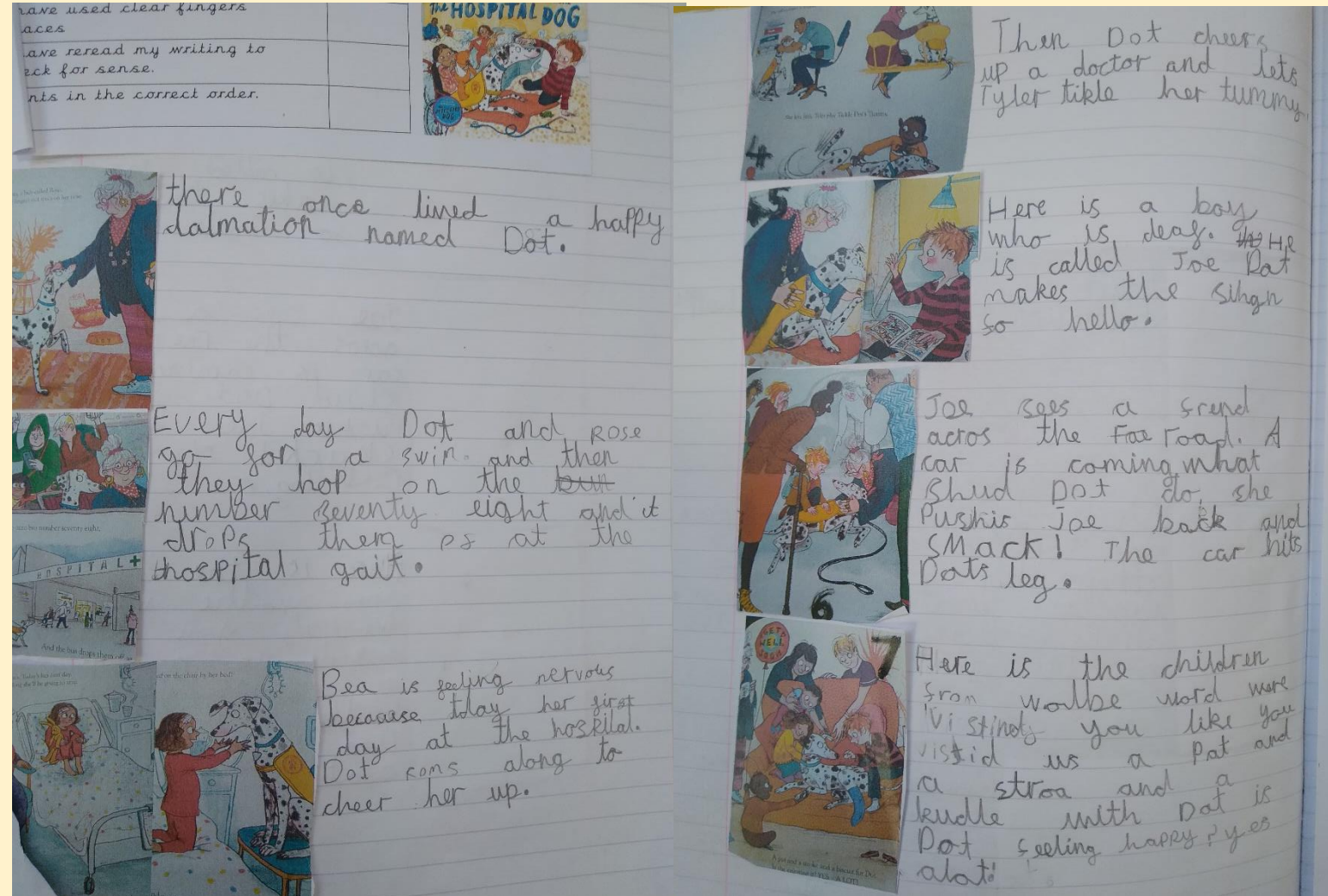
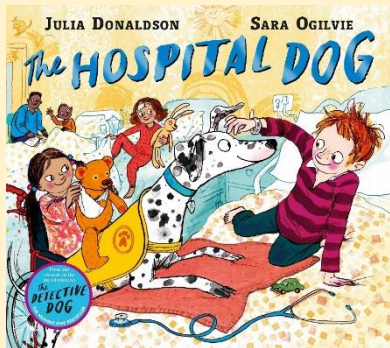
We have also looked at famous scientists from the past with a focus on Marie Curie. We were fascinated to learn all about her scientific discoveries involving medicines and x-rays.

Class 4 – Ambulance visit

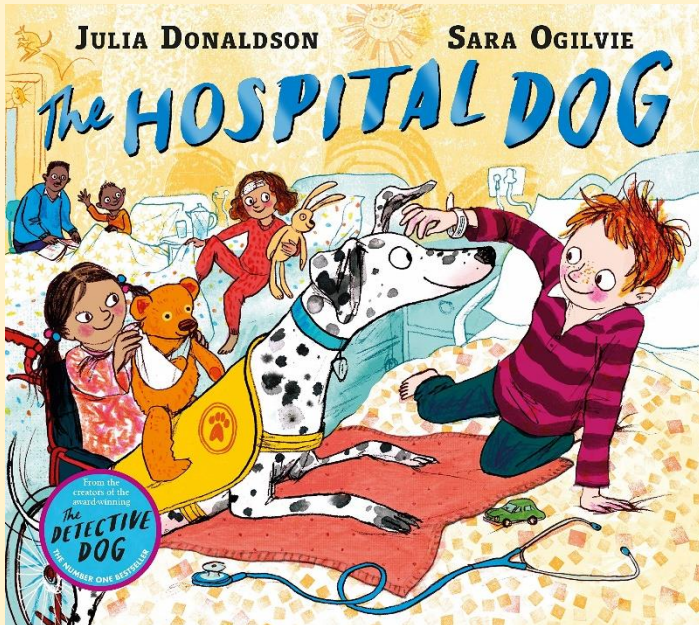
As part of our learning project, Mr Lichtarowicz visited us with an ambulance. We got to explore the vehicle and find out what it involves to be a paramedic.



Class 5 - English



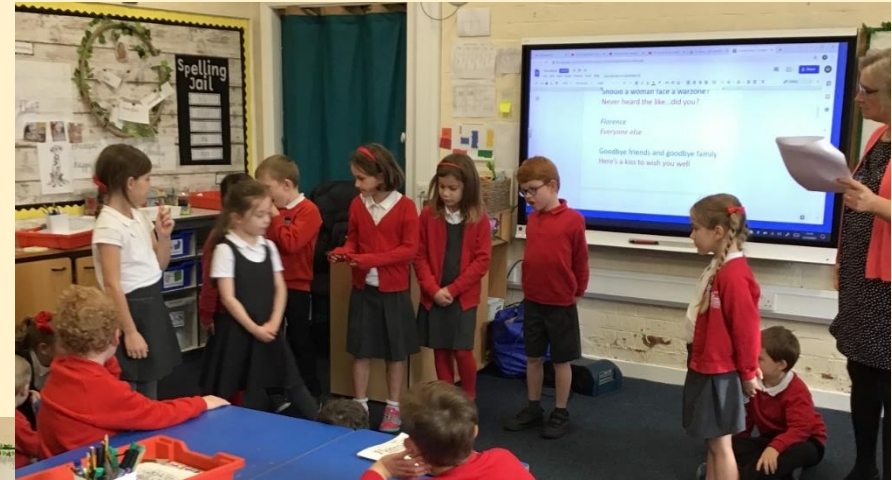

Class 5 - drama



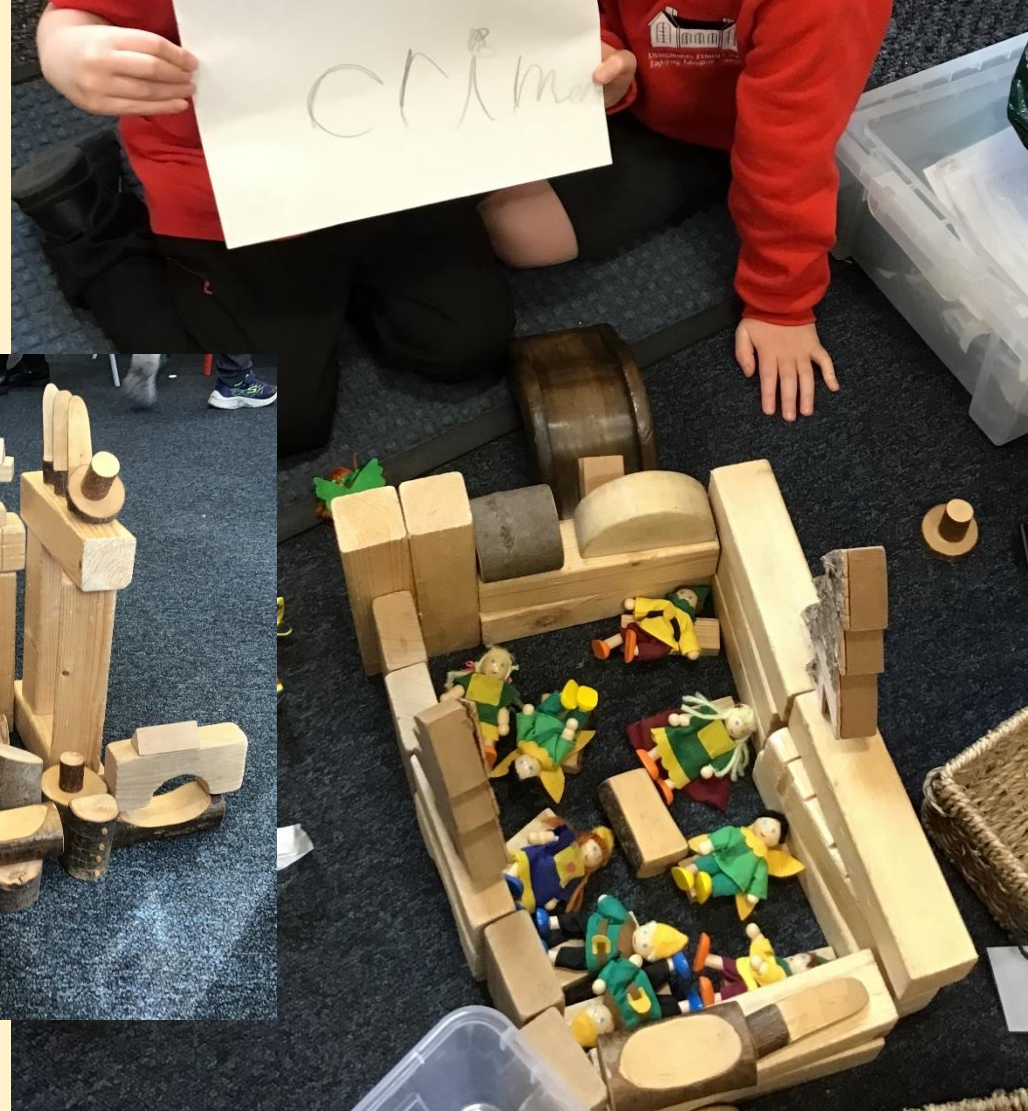
- We have enjoyed learning about Florence Nightingale and how she helped to change hospitals for the better. We have been rehearsing for a play about her.

- We then used our painting to create a mosaic which we shared at Harvest Festival.

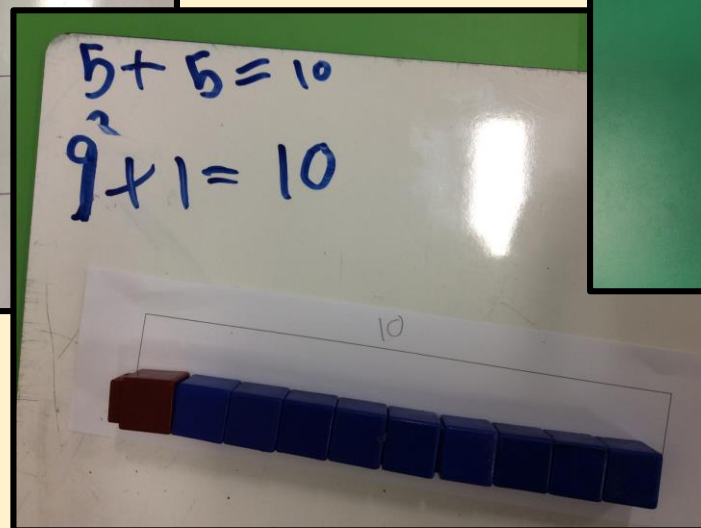
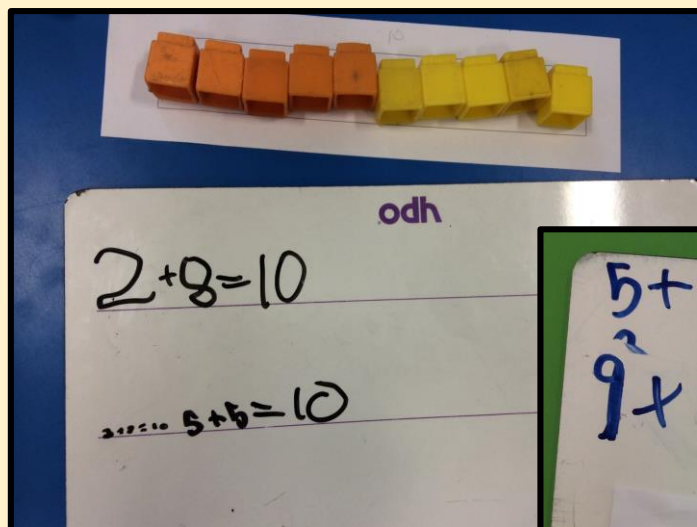

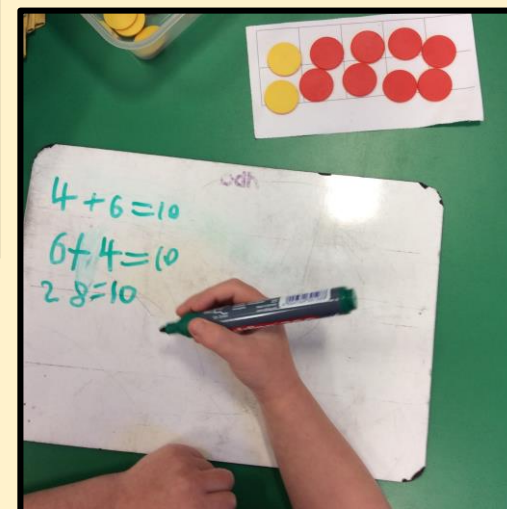
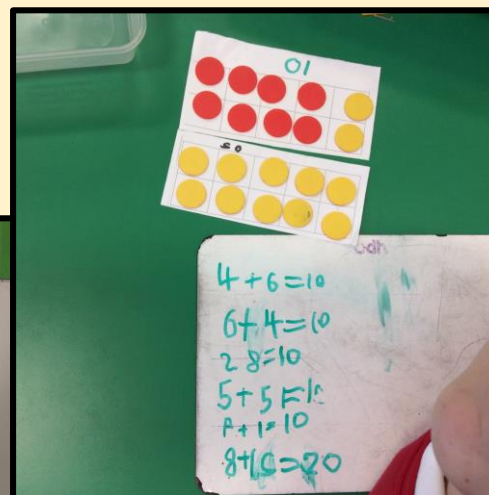


- In maths this half term we have been learning about different ways to represent how to calculate to 10 and 20.

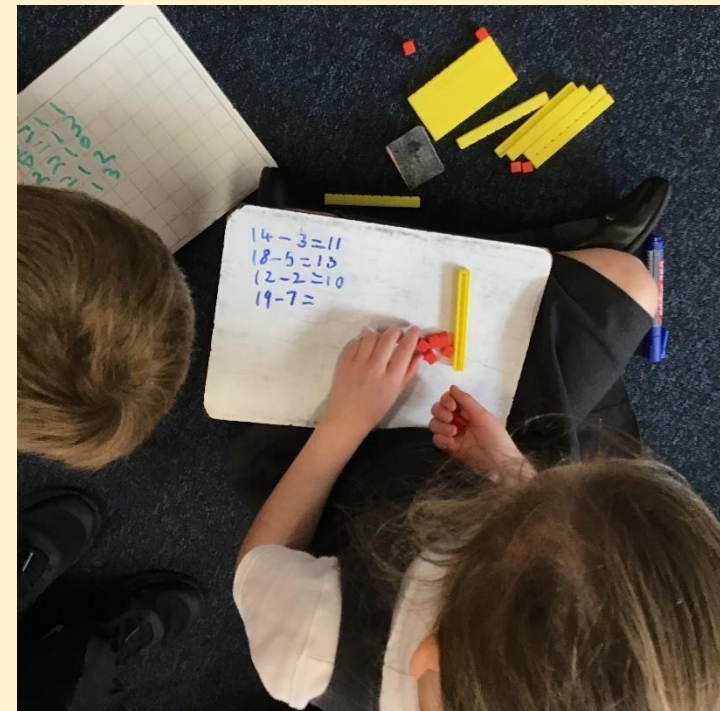
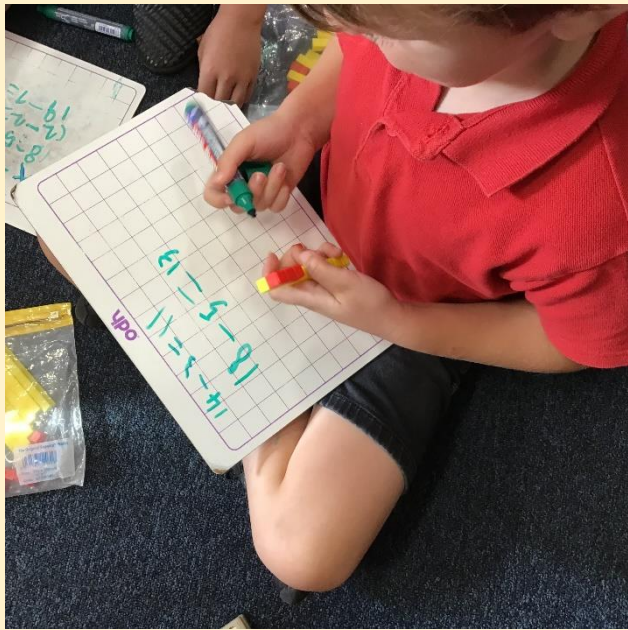
