YSSN buy in	£8300	York School Sport Network facilitates inter competition up to Level 5. It also includes CPD support for staff and half-termly PE specialist to work alongside teachers to develop their teaching ability within P.E. Additional extra-curricular club provided and training of Y5/6 playground leaders.
Swimming support fund	£1200	Year 1 and 2 children undertake weekly swimming lessons for a 6 week block. Children in Year 6 also received booster swimming sessions as catch up (those children who can swim focus on life rescue skills)/
P.E resource budget	£1000	The P.E resource budget will support the increasing need for more equipment in light of the pandemic and resulting, ongoing restrictions, ongoing restrictions. Newly planned 'virtual' competitions will also require additional competition resources.
ASCs	£1500	External ASC providers bought to increase participation with after school sports. Providing clubs that can not or are not currently provided within school.
PGL residential top up	£5663	Due to cancellation of school trip as a result of the pandemic, the trip was rescheduled. This rescheduling
