

Gardening Club Update

A little update from our gardening club.

We are still working hard at clearing all the weeds and old plants from the beds, and covering them with leaves to help feed the soil. We have managed to clear four of the six beds so far! We were very excited today to finally be planting something, and that something was garlic!



We talked about all the different meals that might have garlic in and the children said they hoped they would be able to use it in the school kitchen and how wonderful it would be to eat something that they had grown.

When planting we talked about how to identify which part of the garlic seed clove was the top and bottom and why it was important to plant them the right way.

We marked our rows of newly planted garlic with canes and rocks and can't wait to watch then grow over the coming weeks.
