## **Phase Dates**

**Homework**: Called "Home Learning" set on a **Friday** via Tapestry to be completed for the following **Thursday**, again via Tapestry.

**Trips:** During the last week of the half-term, we are very lucky to be visited by a theatre company that will be performing their interpretations of well-known fairy-tales. This will tie into last half-terms learning - we are very excited! We will also be taking part in a Reception outdoor learning day.

**P.E:** To encourage the children's growing independence, we ask that children bring their P.E. kit into school at the start of the half-term to change into at school on P.E. days. Their kit will be kept in their locker and will be sent home during the half-term to be washed.

**Reading books**: Please support your child's reading by reading and using the phonics flashcards and going through the 'tricky' word bookmark (focussing on 3 words at a time) at the back of the book everytime you hear your child read. Please also record your child's reading in the yellow book. Ideally everyday, but **minimum five days a week**. Please send in your child's reading book and reading record **every day**.

As the weather gets warmer, your child will be provided with a named sunhat that will be kept in school. Please ensure that your child is sent to school with a named water bottle so that they can keep hydrated throughout the day. On sunny days, please ensure that you have applied suncream on your child **before** they come to school. Your child can then bring their suncream to school in a named container for them to apply themselves during the day.
