




### Can you solve the... Wordsearch?

## Design your very own... Christmas Wreath

### Make a natural Christmas wreath with Hannah the horse.

Take a foraging walk along the Trail to gather berries, pinecones, pine needles & twigs for this creative craft

You will need:							
	Large and medium size dinner plates		Scissors		Cardboard		
	PVA Glue		Ribbon or string		Berries, pine twigs, fir or preedles	-	

Place the larger plate on the cardboard and carefully draw around it.

- Place the smaller plate in the middle of the larger circle and carefully draw around it.
- Cut it out then cut the smaller circle in the middle to make a ring.
- Paint one side of your cardboard ring green.
- Decorate your ring by gluing on the natural items you collected, then leave the glue to dry.
- Carefully pierce a hole in the cardboard, thread string or ribbon through the hole, then tie it in a loop so you can hang it up.

# Set baking... Xmas Pudding Krispies



### Help Ford the Fox make some festive krispies!

#### You will need:

- 100 g Butter
- 200 g Mars bars chopped up
- 2 tbsps Golden syrup

- 140 q Rice krispies
- 180 g White chocolate
- Christmas sprinkles
- Grease and line the holes of a 12 hole muffin tin with baking paper.
- Chop the Mars bars into smaller pieces, then add them to the saucepan along with the butter and the golden syrup.
- Place the pan over a low heat and stir until it has all melted together.
- Place the rice krispies into a large mixing bowl, then pour the melted chocolate mixture over. Mix well until the rice krispies are completely coated.
- Spoon the mixture into the lined muffin tin holes and press it down firmly.
- 6 Once set, turn them out so you have Xmas pudding shapes.
- Melt the white chocolate in a heat proof bowl over a pan of simmering water.
- **?** Once fully melted spoon it over the top of the Xmas Krispie cakes, then decorate with Christmas sprinkles.
- Place them in to the fridge for an hour or so until the chocolate has set.


