Reminders


- Our fantastic school library is open every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 3:15-3:45pm.

Read **20 minutes** a day and you'll read 1,800,000 words per year.


Reading in Winter

I'd like any Lottie Brooks book because they're really funny and I enjoy them. I'd love to read the Christmas version.


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


Why not get a head start in your learning?









Lower Key Stage 2 (Years 3 and 4) - York, Glorious Yorl

Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2) - Iceberg Ahead!








Upper Key Stage 2 (Years 5 and 6) - Our Local History (WW2)
