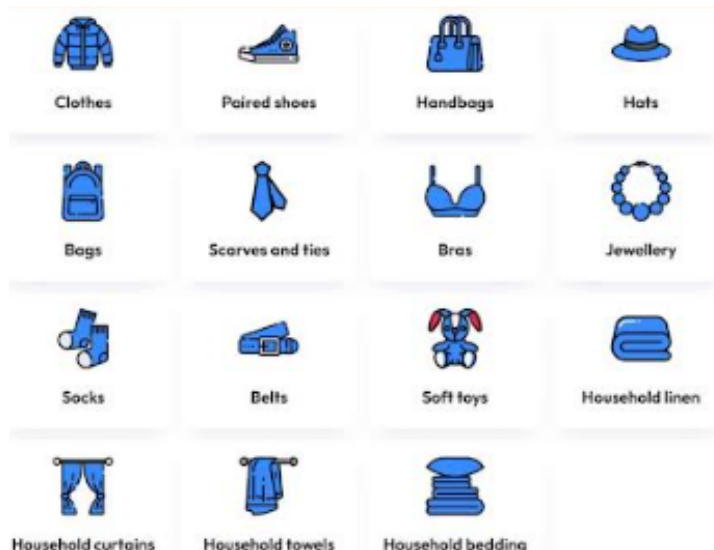
KEY STAGE 1
